

SRJC Dental Hygiene Program Application Instructions

Fall 2026 Admission

Filing Period: 8am, October 6, 2025 – 5pm, January 23, 2026

New this application cycle:

- *Science courses - All courses must have been taken within the last 7 years. If applying to the Fall 2026 cohort (Application period October 2025 - January 2026), courses must have been taken Fall 2019 or later. No exceptions.*
- *Science minimum GPA - 2.75*

Prior to beginning the online application:

1. Read all information about the Dental Hygiene Program and Application Requirements on the Dental Hygiene Program Website: <https://dentalprograms.santarosa.edu>
2. You must be an SRJC student with a SID#. If you are not, you will need to complete the application through Admissions & Records. This process is at no cost to you and can be accessed here: <https://admissions.santarosa.edu/apply>
3. Meet with a Counselor to go over your pre-requisites, DH major and General Ed Associate's Degree requirements and obtain assistance completing any necessary course substitutions. Not doing so may cause delays and jeopardize your eligibility for the lottery.

The Dental Hygiene Program Director and Health Sciences Staff cannot answer course equivalency questions. You must be registered as a student and meet with a counselor to have these questions answered.

Application Procedure:

Once you have completed the above, you are now ready to fill out the online application:

4. **Read through the Application Requirements, follow the Application Instructions and Complete the Demographic portion of the application:**
 - All sections in the Online Application Form marked with a grey asterisk (*) must be completed in order to submit your online application.

5. **Program Prerequisites and College Transcripts:**

- **For prerequisites completed at SRJC:** Upload an unofficial copy of your SRJC transcript (printed from your student portal) to the online application. You DO NOT need to send an official copy of your SRJC transcript to Admissions & Records. Screen shots of your SRJC transcript will not be accepted.
- **For prerequisites completed at institutions other than SRJC:** You will list these institutions in order starting with the most current. In addition, you must separately send official transcripts from all non-SRJC institutions attended with the exception of your SRJC Transcript to Admissions & Records:

- SRJC accepts Electronic transcripts (e-transcripts) from the following exchange services:
 - eTranscripts for California
 - National Student Clearinghouse
 - Parchment
 - eScript-Safe
 - World Education Services (WES)
 - Credential Services
 - Joint Services Military
- If you are not using these services, transcripts sent electronically must be received directly from the granting institution or transcript vendor and sent to evaluations@santarosa.edu. **Note:** Transcripts sent directly through a personal email and as a direct email attachment will not be accepted.

- Exceptions:
 - If you believe you have already submitted your most up-to-date official transcripts from other colleges to SRJC's Admissions & Records, please follow these instructions:
 - Contact Admissions Evaluations Office at (707) 527-4517 to verify all official transcripts are on file; OR, Contact Counseling for a Quick Question drop-in (707) 527-4451 to verify your official transcripts are on file.

- **Important information regarding transcripts:**
 - Applications that do not have official transcripts on file with A&R by **January 30, 2026**, will be considered as incomplete and will not be eligible for the lottery.
 - If you have transcripts from other institutions, you may request to have a Transfer Credit Evaluation of your transcripts by Admissions & Records:

 - Transcripts hand delivered or sent directly to Health Sciences, either official or unofficial, will not be accepted. No exceptions.
- 6. **Complete the Prerequisite Course Work section of the application**– Refer to the Directions listed under this section of the online application.
 - **Course Substitutions** – You are encouraged to meet with a counselor to help you determine if course substitutions are necessary.
 - **What if I don't meet with a counselor and it's determined that I need a course substitution during the application review process?** Not completing all necessary course substitutions prior to submitting your online application could cause delays in processing your application and jeopardize your eligibility for the lottery.
- 7. **Make a copy of your application** – It is your responsibility to keep a record of your application. You may copy the document and paste in to a separate Word document for saving for your records or print a hard copy. Health Sciences cannot provide you with a copy of your application.
- 8. **Submit your application** – Please make sure to review your application thoroughly for accuracy. Once all required fields are completed, including uploading your SRJC transcript as applicable, use your mouse or finger to sign your name and click “Submit”.
- 9. **Confirmation of submission** - Once you click submit, a new screen will pop up with confirmation of submission. This is your acknowledgement that your application has been received. Do not call or email Health Sciences or the Program Director for confirmation.
